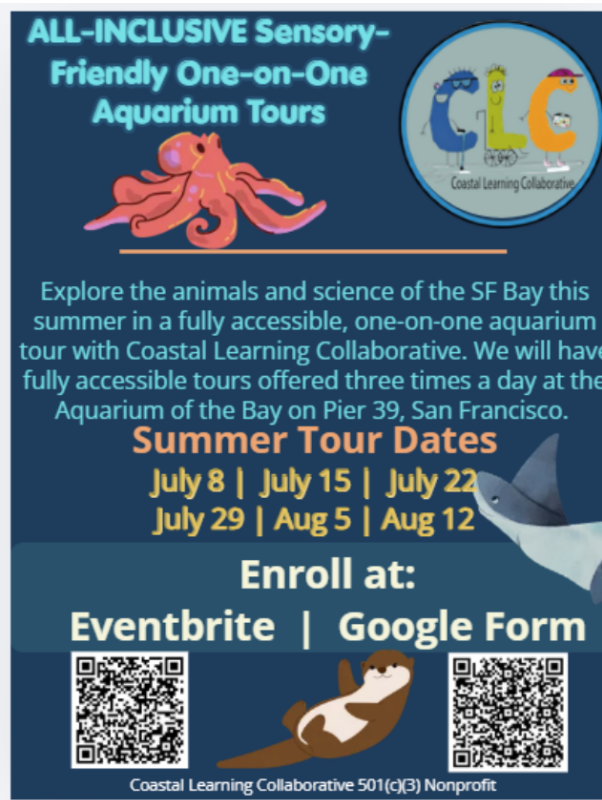
Upcoming CLC Events!

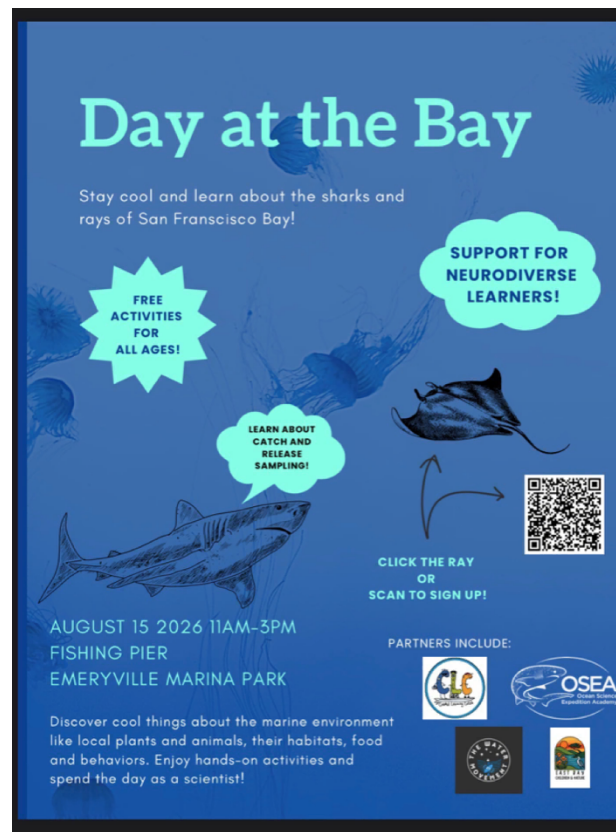
Free “Day At the Bay” Event in Emeryville! Sign-Ups Required!

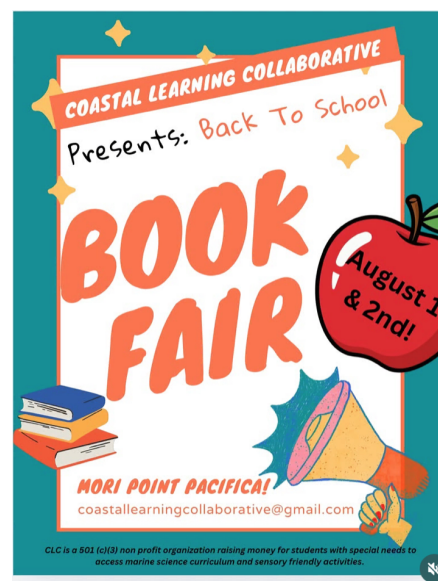

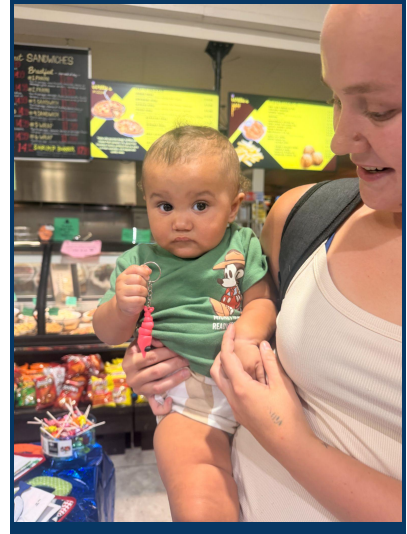
